Qualification level:

This course is presented at Post-graduate NQF Level 8



Duration of study:

A compact 1-year programme with a maximum completion time of 3 years.



Mode of Delivery:

Flexible study modes - full-time contact or part-time contact mode with a blended approach for contact sessions, or distance-based (online) for remote learners.



Language of Tuition:

Coursework is conducted entirely in English.



Sites of delivery for Contact Modes:

Benefit from in-person study schools and workshops at our North-West campuses, bolstered by convenient synchronous remote sessions you can join from your home or office.

Credit load:

Our professional PGDip programme carries 120 SAQA credits.



Time-requirement:

Be prepared for self-directed learning. You will need approximately 1200 hours to complete this qualification. For every hour spent in class, anticipate an additional 4 hours for reading, group work and assignments.



Learning Activities:

Rich learning experiences await, in the form of lectures, guest lectures, panel discussions, service & work-integrated learning assignments, syndicate group work and self-study via our online learning management system (eFundi).



Assessment:

Assessment involves a combination of practical assignments, in which you will apply theoretical concepts to your own context or group work, as well as a portfolio submission.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

At the NWU Business School, we uphold rigorous admission standards to ensure the quality and excellence of our Post-graduate Diploma in Management. We benchmark our admission criteria against accredited business schools and industry best practices.

All applicants must fulfil the following minimum requirements:

◆ Admission Requirements:

- Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree with 360 credits.
- BTech or Advanced Diploma (NQF 7) Students: Candidates with a BTech (NQF 7) will be considered if they achieved a 60% mark in their final year of study, and have at least two years of relevant work experience.
- Candidates must have at least two years of proven, relevant work experience or achieve a 60% pass rate in all final-year prescribed modules in the third- or fourth (final) year of their undergraduate programme.
- Applicants must be computer literate and have internet access.

◆ Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL):

- Candidates who hold qualifications below the required NQF Level 7 may apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), provided they have sufficient relevant managerial experience. Please note that the closing date for RPL applications is 31 July 2026.

For part-time/distance learning students, modules can be spread over two years to better manage workload and study commitments.

Study schools & Workshops

Part-time and full-time students are required to travel to the study schools twice per semester, and all students will be responsible for their travel and accommodation during the study school. Study Schools will run for two - three days with speakers and networking events in the evenings.



ACCESS TO TECHNOLOGY AT NWU BUSINESS SCHOOL
